Euan Morton, a native of Scotland, received an Olivier Award nomination for originating the role of **Boy George** in the musical *Taboo*. He reprised the role in 2003 on Broadway, earning **Tony, Drama Desk, Outer Critics Circle and Drama League Award** nominations, as well as the Theatre World Award (for Outstanding Broadway Debut).

Euan is currently appearing with Alfred Molina in **HOWARD KATZ** at the Roundabout Theatre in NY, and is also featured in a documentary called **SHOW BUSINESS** which is about to be released nationally. Euan recently earned a 2006 Obie Award for *Measure For Pleasure* at the Public Theatre. His other stage appearances include title roles in: Tony Kushner's *Brundibár* at the New Victory Theatre and Berkeley Rep; *The Who's Tommy* at the Bay Street Theatre; and *Caligula* for the inaugural season of the New York Musical Theatre Festival (2004 NYMF Award for Outstanding Individual Performance). Euan has released his debut solo CD, *NewClear*, and has appeared in concert in New York City at Town Hall, The Zipper, Joe's Pub and Birdland, as well as at the Signature Theatre in Arlington, VA, and with Mark Shugall's ARTSPEAK!

Euan has conducted master classes in the craft of acting and singing all over the U.S.
