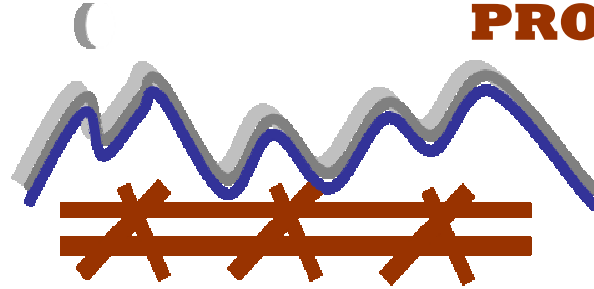




The Laramie PROJECT
